### Housing

○ Bunkhouse:

This includes bathrooms and bunk beds. Sleeping bags, towels and toiletries should be brought with you.

\$10 per night or

\$60 per week (per person)

\*Groups charge limit is \$700/night.

○ Tents:

This includes the use of Pathfinders Tents. There is no charge for camping if you use your own tents. Sleeping bags are available upon request at \$2/night or \$5/week.

Tents (no shower facilities) (\$5 per night)

Tents with shower facilities) (\$10 per night)

## Ropes Course/Teambuilding Activities

### Low Ropes and Initiatives

- Students

\$8 per hour

\$25 per 4 hours

- Adults

\$10 per hour

\$35 per 4 hours

### High Ropes (Available Spring 2010)

- Students

\$15 per hour

\$50 per 4 hours

- Adults

\$20 per hour

\$70 per 4 hours

## Rock Climbing and Rappelling:

This includes instruction, safety, and equipment at Backbone Rock in Damascus, Tennessee.

○ Students and Adults are \$40 for the day 4 hours of 'rockin' time.

\*Transportation is to be provided by the group.

## Paintball

Field/Equipment Charge:

This includes marker/gun and mask. There is a minimum charge of 10 participants for the paintball course.

\$11/person for 2 hours of play

Paint:       \$3 per hundred  
              \$45 per case (average of 1000 paintballs)

*The average for 15 people to play for 2 hours is 3 cases which is approximately \$9 per person (when purchased by the case)*

## Horseback Riding

\$10 per hour minimum 5 participants

(This is an off campus event and requires 10 minutes of drive time each way)

## LAKE

The lake is open for use but all participants must be wearing a life-jacket and have a lifeguard.

## Hiking Trails

All of our beautiful hiking trails are open for your enjoyment. Remember that there are animals such as snakes in the woods so please be careful and enjoy your stay!
