Online Registration

Please complete the full online registration process; payment, release forms, medical history etc...

Cancellations

It is understandable that plans are altered due to unforeseen circumstances. If your plans do change, our cancellation policy is as follows:

- 100% of registration fees and payment are transferable to a previously unregistered guest.
- Cancellations prior to May 1st receive a full refund less the registration deposit.
- Cancellations after May 1st are non-refundable unless the space is filled from our waiting list.
- No-shows are ineligible for a refund.

Special Needs Assistance

If your student has specific needs, such as dietary, physical, behavioral, or emotional needs, please make indications on your child's medical form. This information will be relayed to the appropriate staff members in order to provide the best experience for your child.

Late Arrivals

WHILE YOU'RE HERE



Check-In

Check-in is Monday between 9am-11:30am. When you arrive follow the signs to the office and registration area for the check-in process.

Medications and Inhalers

Please do not pack any medications in your student's luggage. All medication must be turned over to the medical staff upon arrival. If your student requires prescription medications while at camp, please bring an adequate supply of the medication in the **original**, clearly labeled prescription container and check it in with the Medical Staff. State Law prohibits us from accepting medications in any other pill case or container. Medications are secured in our health office and distributed according to instructions by a Medical Staff. There is no need to send Tylenol or other over-the-counter remedies. We keep a supply of these items in our health office in case your student needs treatment. Please also refrain from sending vitamins or other non-prescription medications that are not essential for maintaining your student's health during their stay. If they use an inhaler, please send two inhalers—one for the counselor to carry during the day and one to be kept in the health office for back-up.

Prohibited Items Inspection:

For safety purposes your student's bags will be checked in their presence by a staff member, for any prohibited items. Those items will be given to their Parent/Guardian before they leave or collected and returned at the end of the week. Please pack only the allowed items for their stay! (See "What To Bring" list in Pre-Arrival Package)

Communicating with Your Student

Every day during camp we will load pictures in the "PathfindersYouthCamp" facebook fan page, in the album section. If you would like to be apart just "Like" PathfindersYouthCamp facebook fan page. See website for direct link www.pathfindersonline.com. Check daily during camp to see what's happening with your child at camp! Feel free to tag their photos and leave comments. Postal mail and care packages are not recommended as they often arrive too late.

"Path Bucks" Spending Money

Students can deposit money into the camp bank for snacks, shirts, and gifts at The Narrow Path Canteen. Shirts and gifts range from \$8-\$20 and most snacks are \$1 or less.

Health & Safety

At Pathfinders your student's safety is our #1 priority. While danger is inherent in any adventure activity, Pathfinders seeks to minimize that danger through well-designed courses, top-of-the-line equipment, and well-trained staff. All adventure courses are professionally designed and independently inspected. All summer staff members receive training prior to camp that emphasizes physical and emotional safety for students. Pathfinders maintains an infirmary with a licensed nurse or other trained medical professionals available.

Withdrawal

If your student must withdraw from a program before the session ends, no refund will be given. Pathfinders reserves the right to dismiss anyone without refund whose conduct is not in the best interest of other participants.

Vehicles

Your student's personal vehicle is not permitted on the premises during their stay. Please make arrangements to bring and pick up your students.

Check-out Details

Student check-out is Saturday 10am. Please make every effort to arrive at this time. You or the adult picking up your student on closing day must have the pick-up slip that was given on opening day in order to pick-up student. At check-out you will receive any balance in your child's "Path Bucks" account and unused medications and inhalers. Early check-out is highly discouraged and should only be considered in extreme circumstances. Arrangements for early departure must be made directly with the registrar at or before opening day.

The Narrow Path Canteen

The Narrow Path Canteen store will be open on departure day so that you or your student can purchase last minute souvenirs or other items.

Lost and Found

Lost and found items will be on tables as you depart. Please be sure to check this table for any items your student has lost. We want to help your student leave with everything they brought. Pathfinders is not responsible for lost, stolen or misplaced articles. Items left behind will be held for one week only, then donated to charity.

WHAT TO BRING



How to Pack

Please pack all items in soft-shell luggage or duffle bag, if possible, for easy storage (2 bags maximum, please!). Be sure to label ALL ITEMS clearly using nametags, labels or marker, to ensure things return home with you!

All Students Bring:

- Sleeping Bag or 2 Flat Sheet and 1 Blanket
- Pillow and Pillowcase
- Bath Towel and Wash Cloth
- Soap, Shampoo, Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Toiletries
- Pajamas
- Underwear and Socks (lots)
- 1-2 Pairs Athletic/Tennis Shoes
- Sandals (with heel strap) and Flip-Flops (for shower)
- Windbreaker or Jacket, and hooded Raincoat or Poncho
- Swimming Trunks (guys), modest one-piece Bathing Suit (girls)
- Beach Towel
- 5-8 Short-Sleeved Shirts and 1-2 Sweatshirts
- 5 pairs of modest Shorts and 2 pairs of Long Pants
- 1 set of clothes that can get very muddy and possibly thrown away
- Sunglasses, Sunscreen, Bug-Spray
- Flashlight
- Laundry Bag and a separate bag for wet clothes
- Bible, Pen, Journal or Notebook
- Prescription Medicine in original container with instructions (must be given to medical staff at check-in)
- Optional:* Hat, Bandana, Water Bottle, Camera, Nose or Ear Plugs for water, Money to purchase "Path Bucks" for canteen use.
- Theme night clothing & accessories (will post theme closer to camp date)

Prohibited Items:

- Over-The-Counter Medications, Vitamins
- Electronics including, Handheld Games, Laptops
- Radio, CD Player
- Food, Gum, or Energy Drinks
- Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco Products, Illegal Drugs
- Knives, Firearms, Fireworks

NEW POLICY: We are allowing students to bring their cell phones if desired, however they will need to turn them in at registration. We will be giving the students their phones back to use during canteen time and then re-collecting each night. If students do not hand them back in and are found by a staff member their phones will be held for the remainder of their camp week.

Although not prohibited, jewelry and valuables, are discouraged. Personal Mp3 players or iPods for use in the bunk-house only. Pathfinders cannot be held responsible for these items in the event of loss or theft.
